1. Sign in to Australia/New Zealand Reference Centre Plus here: www.rotorualibrary.govt.nz/browse/Pages/Online-Databases.aspx using your library barcode number and PIN
2. Enter your search query
3. Refine the list using the options listed on the left eg; newspapers, magazines, trade publications etc.
4. When you are satisfied with the information provided, you can print or export the article. In many cases, you can "listen" to the article too.

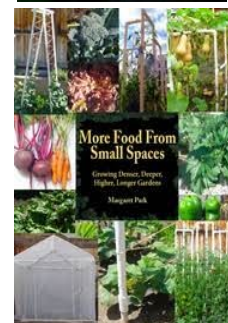
