

Children must be supervised while in the Library

Rotorua Library provides a place for children and adults to have fun and explore together.

We remind parents and guardians that they are responsible for the supervision and behaviour of their children while they are in the library.

Children should always be accompanied by an adult and should not be left on their own in the library. Responsibility for the safety of children who are not supervised by a caregiver does not rest with library staff.

If it becomes evident that children under 14 years of age have been left unsupervised, the police will be contacted and the children uplifted by Youth Services (Reference Section 10B of the Summary Offences Act 1981.)
